EXPANDED INCENTIVES = NEW RISK MANAGEMENT DOLLARS AND SAVINGS!

Looking for new money that can help save money?

CIS is proud to provide financial incentives to member entities to help create safer workplaces, communities and organizations. Not only is it the right thing to do, it can save money by reducing potential claims.

Risk Management Incentive Program

For the past two years CIS has offered Risk Management Grants to entities that meet specific criteria. New safety equipment was purchased, trainings were conducted and facility and community safety improvements were funded through the Grants. Because the initial programs have been successful, the Board of Trustees has authorized expanding funding and access.

NEW NAME

Risk Management Incentive Program better describes the newly expanded program and removes the word "grant" which helps clarify that the funds don't need to be paid back and applying for them doesn't require administrative time or expense.

EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY

Starting in August, 2010 CIS will offer Risk Management Incentives to all Liability Program member entities, regardless of size.

STARTING OVER

The previous funding was tied to a three-year window, making some entities not eligible for new funding till 2011/2012. We're beginning a new three-year cycle with FY 2010/2011 thanks to this expansion.



NO MORE RESOLUTION REQUIREMENT!

We've replaced the resolution requirement with a simple Incentive Agreement between the entity and CIS.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

Members who had General and Auto Liability Coverage in 2009 with CIS are eligible. The amount available to each is based on the premium they pay and is a maximum of 25% of the FY 2009/2010 liability contribution or \$10,000, whichever is lower.

The following action steps are all you need to do to apply for the Risk Management Incentives:

- Submit an application demonstrating how the project meets risk management goals with measurable outcomes.
- Spend the funding on risk management or loss control-related expenses.
- Commit, by signing the Incentive Agreement, to continue with CIS for three years.

Law Enforcement Incentive Program

Reducing risk for law enforcement agencies is a specialized need. CIS recognizes that need and has developed training and policy development incentives that are available to members who are covered with CIS General & Auto Liability Insurance.

TRAINING INCENTIVES

CIS may offer trainings targeted to the special needs of Law Enforcement community that can help reduce risk and lower claims.

POLICY DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES

Funding will be distributed to law enforcement agencies to develop and implement policies aimed at reducing risk. Agencies can apply for funding to pay for Lexipol Policy Program. CIS will provide funding assistance for the first year's membership with Lexipol.

OREGON ACCREDITATION ALLIANCE

CIS is also proud to offer funding assistance to become accredited through (OAA) Oregon Accreditation Alliance. This is for new members of OAA only.

Return to Work Incentive Program

Returning employees to work as soon as possible following an on-the-job injury is a key goal of CIS' Workers' Compensation Program. Members that have Workers' Compensation coverage through CIS can apply for the Return to Work Incentive Program. Typically this incentive supports costs associated with accommodations that may be needed and supplements the State of Oregon's Employer-at-Injury Program (EAIP) monies.
