CIS Learning Center Entity Admin Update

UPDATES AND NEW LANDING PAGE

The CIS Learning Center (CLC) is getting a new look for Learners. The anticipated launch date for the new landing page is Wednesday, August 10. Our June 9 webinar for Entity Admins provided a preview of the new landing page and the updated "Getting Started" materials that go along with it. COSMETIC IMPROVEMENTS

SumTotal Systems, our vendor for the CIS Learning Center (CLC), has made several cosmetic updates to the CLC platform. The updates include relocating navigation buttons from the bottom of the page to the top of the page, adding floating buttons to several pages, changing the look of the pagination, and adding "breadcrumbs" to the various wizards. These updates are expected to continue for the next few months as they fine tune the design and make the changes on additional pages. <u>Click</u> <u>here</u> for some examples of the changes.

One of the changes has had a direct impact on how users enroll in an Instructor-led class. Previously, there was an "Enroll in this Class" button under the list of classes that would highlight once a class was selected. This no longer looks like a button and has been moved above the list of classes. An example of the new look is below.

NEW USER CREATION NOTIFICATION AND PASSWORD UPDATES

A recent update by our vendor has changed the password process for new user accounts requested by CIS member-employees via the Login page. They will now receive a notification that requires them to click on a link to activate their account. We have updated the

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notification to make this clearer and to remove the previous reference to the temporary password, "Online1!". New Users will be able to set their own passwords immediately when creating an account.

Also, we have re-activated the notification for User Creation Event. This is the email that employees receive confirming that their new account has been created. What this means for you as Entity Admins is that **you no longer need to enter a password when creating a user, nor will you need to manually send the New User Email** template on the Entity Admin webpage. We have updated the language in the notification to reflect these changes.

Initially, we turned off this notification because many of the admins doing bulk uploads didn't want people to know right away they had accounts. They wanted to stagger the implementation and notify people as needed. We can still do this on a case-by-case basis, if necessary. Let us know at the time you submit your batch import.

CLC COURSE UPDATES

Certification CEUs

The CLC has over 200 courses that are approved for LGMC, DPSST, OESAC, OSACA, HRCI-SHRM, and OR-PRIMA's Risk Management Certification CEUs. A complete list, sortable by type, can be found <u>here</u>. The course description page in the CLC also includes information on any CEUs approved for the course. If you or a staff member are hoping to receive CEUs for a specific class, please confirm that it has been pre-approved for those CEUs. Most approving agencies require that the course has been approved for the credits prior to the date of the training being completed. Approval for some credit types can take at least two months.

If you have learners who are working towards or maintaining a certification, avoid the last minute rush and assign the required courses to your employees with plenty of time for them to finish the course prior to their certification deadlines. If it's an annual requirement, you can set-up courses to be automatically reassigned annually. Contact us at learn@cisoregon.org if you need assistance creating a learning plan or assignment.

INSTRUCTOR-LED TRAINING HANDOUTS

Our trainers have seen a large increase in the number of people arriving for trainings without printing the handouts ahead of time. Several years ago, CIS made the decision to go paper-free. All of the handouts available for our trainings are listed on the Activities page of the course in the CIS Learning Center and require only that the member be able to view PDF documents in order to print or download. 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We are finding that the following issues are contributing to the confusion:

- A large number of people are being registered by their Entity Admin either directly via Class Manager or through a list being emailed to <u>learn@cisoregon.org</u>. This seems to cause a disconnect between the registrants understanding what the CIS Learning Center (CLC) is and what website to go to download their materials. The majority of the calls we have received are from people trying to log into the wrong website.
- Several registrants do not know their username or password. It's either been too long since they received one or they never received one.
- Registrants are not receiving their notifications. The notifications are sent by the CLC system, but if registrants haven't whitelisted the CLC email address they do not receive them. The whitelist information is available on the <u>Entity Admin Resources webpage</u> under "System Compatibility." We also request that you have your IT department whitelist the following domain to ensure that notifications are received: gm1.geolearning.com.
- Also, several people are registered with an invalid email and set-up for their supervisors to receive their notifications. If this is the case, notifications may not be reaching the registrant. Please be sure to pass the information along to your employee(s).

In order to alleviate some of these issues, we ask that you be sure your staff is aware of their username, password, and the website address of the CLC if you register them on their behalf. If your staff is unable to access the documents themselves, we ask that you provide the documents to them.
